

Minister Esther Turner Uganda Missions Trip – April 4 – May 4, 2019

Minister Esther Turner will be leaving for her yearly Uganda Missions Trip on April 4th. In addition to the travel expenses, there's still a lot of work to do in the villages that she visits. Another water tanker will be installed in a village so that the children can have clean water. She would also like to bless 150 teen girls with reusable sanitary pad kits which will last for a year. One kit is \$4.70 and can be donated by signing up on the sheet on the Missions board in the foyer. Help will be given to the youth pastor to bring teen boys who are on drugs off of the street and into a shelter. 400 kids in 3 villages will be fed and the pig project is still growing.
